

COMMUNITY GROUP QUESTIONS

OPEN: Many of us have humorous or awkward stories of how our parents “broke the news” to us about sex. Do you have a story you can share? Why do you think so many parents are hesitant or uncomfortable sharing openly about this subject? Do you agree or disagree with Pastor Scott’s notion of the church doing a poor job of helping the family with this subject?

DIG: Read Matthew 5:27-28. Do you believe that sex is much more a matter of “mind” than we are willing to admit? Why or why not? What is significant about Jesus’ use of the word “adultery”?

Why is sex a gift from God? What does sex do for us? What does it mean and where does it belong?

What, if anything, about pagan expressions of sexual behavior are disturbing to you? Why? Do you believe women are victims of the sexual revolution more than men? Why or why not?

Why do you agree or disagree with the following statement: *Sex education begins at birth!*

REFLECT: Read 1 Thessalonians 4:1-8 and 1 Corinthians 7:2-3. How does Paul’s advice go against the grain in that time and in ours?
