

COMMUNITY GROUP QUESTIONS

OPEN: Galatians 2:20 says, "It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me." Left on our own, we all have selfish desires. Share an event or time in your life (funny or serious) that helped you realize your own selfishness.

DIG: What does it look like to have Christ on the throne of our lives rather than self? How does this change our personal, family, and work lives?

Does the thought of giving up control of your life scare you? Why or why not? Read Ephesians 6:10-20. How can you be encouraged from this passage?

Read Galatians 2:11-14. How did Peter compromise the gospel? How can we avoid doing the same thing in our lives?

REFLECT: How can the truth that we are justified by faith in Christ rather than by works spur us on to live completely for Jesus?

Pray this week about how you and your group members can allow Christ to work your lives rather than trying to take control yourselves.
