
CGROUP QUESTIONS

OPEN: Who would you nominate for the Good Samaritan Award?

DIG: Read Luke 10:34-37. The best time to show mercy or compassion is when it is needed, not just when we feel like doing it. What risks did the Good Samaritan take by helping this man?

Our walk with God is closely tied with our action toward others. Read James 2:14-26. What does it mean that “faith without works is dead”? What does it mean that “a person is justified by works and not by faith alone”? Aren’t we saved by grace? (Note: the verb *justified* in verses 25-26 means “shown to be righteous” rather than “made righteous.” This signifies that true, living faith is evident **in** our good works to others, not created **by** good works for others.)

If our faith is fulfilled by our actions, then what person do we need to show compassion to

REFLECT: Ask yourself this week, “Who is my neighbor?” Better yet, ask yourself, “Am I being a good neighbor?” Listen to where God guides you and follow through with the opportunities He puts in your path.
