
COMMUNITY GROUP QUESTIONS

OPEN: Who are you, your children, or your pets named after, and why? If you could change your name, what would it be?

DIG: Hebrews 1:1-4 is a "shock and awe" explosion of statements about Jesus (all one sentence in Greek) designed to capture the attention of a "sleepy" audience. What to you is most profound or startling about this passage, and why?

Read Hebrews 1:1-4 and then jump to Hebrews 2:1. What do you learn or take away from this connection?

The first century Christians to whom Hebrews is addressed started out strong (Hebrews 10:32-34), then they drifted, disengaged, and apparently even quit faithfully gathering together. Do you think this is suggestive of the church today? Why, or why not?

REFLECT: Take some time to think, discuss, and pray about where you are personally in your walk with Jesus and how you can (if needed) correct your course in light of who He is.
