# COMMUNITY GROUP QUESTIONS

---

**OPEN:** How do you respond to warning signs, yellow stoplights, and the like (do you ignore them, take them seriously, think they apply only to others, etc.)?

**SCRIPTURE:** Read 1 Corinthians 12:4-11 and Ephesians 1:3-10.

**DIG:** How do these passages clarify the “great salvation” we have, as referenced in the Hebrews 2:1-4 passage we heard on Sunday?

Define “neglect.” What’s the difference between “neglect” and “reject”? What does it mean to “neglect so great a salvation”?

What, if anything, from these passages makes you want to set aside indifference, apathy, laziness, or distractions?

**CHALLENGE:** This week’s sermon passage is an urgent warning, exhortation, and admonition for us to take **SERIOUSLY** our walk with the Lord and the great salvation He offers. What area of your life do you need to rid yourself of apathy or drifting away from the Lord, and instead turn toward Him? Confide in someone you know within your group or another trusted friend who can help and encourage you in this challenge.
