# COMMUNITY GROUP QUESTIONS

**OPEN:** During the many years you were in school, what was your favorite subject, and why did you enjoy it? (Recess doesn't count.)

**DIG:** How does the writer to the Hebrews motivate and challenge his readers to grow? What motivates you to grow in your walk with Jesus?

The writer gives a challenge (Hebrews 5:11-14), a warning (6:1-8), and an encouragement (6:9-11). Which of these three aspects resonates with your heart as a "wake-up call"?

What would people who are closest to you say is the greatest evidence that Jesus is at work in your heart?

Read Hebrews 6:12. Name two or three people you know, or one faithful servant in the Bible (except Jesus), you would like to imitate, and why.
