
COMMUNITY GROUP QUESTIONS

OPEN: Would you rather have an easy job working for someone else, or work for yourself but work incredibly hard?

What stood out from the sermon this week?

READ: Psalm 119:105, Proverbs 3:5, John 14:6, and 2 Timothy 3:16-17.

DIG: According to these verses, what does it mean to keep our eyes focused on Jesus ?

How are you encouraged by reading these passages?

Read John 14:26 (Holy Spirit), Ephesians 6:13 (armor of God), James 1:27 (orphans and widows), and 1 John 1:9 (confession). What actions should we take in our daily lives to keep our eyes fixed on the Lord according to these passages?

Based on these Scriptures, is there one area you are more gifted in than others? Why?

CHALLENGE: There are lots of places, things, and people we could turn to when we need answers. Let's commit to keeping our eyes on the Lord in all things, together. This week, think of a situation you would normally try to take control of. Instead, keep accountable to each other and turn to Jesus first, staying focused on Jesus through the whole process.
