
COMMUNITY GROUP QUESTIONS

OPEN: Would you rather have all your clothes fit perfectly or have the most comfortable pillow, blankets, and sheets in existence?

What stood out from the sermon this week?

READ: Ephesians 6:10-20, 2 Peter 3:3-7, 1 John 2:18-21, and Jude 17-21.

DIG: According to these passages, how are we to understand the reality of the spiritual realm?

On a scale of 1 (never) to 10 (all the time), how often do you think about the spiritual realm of angels and demons and why? Is it fascinating to you or scary?

How do we balance our Christian liberties/enjoying God's creation with making sure our witness to the world is not compromised?

How do we discern between things that God created and things that man has distorted?

If someone says to you, "God doesn't want you to have fun," how can you respond based on your own personal life?

CHALLENGE: We tend to forget about that which we don't see. Ask the Lord to give you a clearer understanding and realization of the unseen spiritual reality that exists. Pray the Lord gives you a desire to learn about the things of the spirit and be unafraid because God is in control of it all!
