OPEN: As we wrap up the *study* portion of this Community Group season and move toward the *servicing* portion, take a moment to pray for the families we will be helping with Christmas Blessings.

What stood out from the sermon this week?

READ: Philippians 4:10-13, Hebrews 13:5, Proverbs 28:20-27, and 30:7-9.

DIG: According to the passages above, what are the temptations for those caught up in the desire to become wealthy? How will the Lord judge them?

What do these passages say are the missing key ingredients for people who are obsessed with wealth? How do we implement these ingredients?

How do 1 Timothy 4:1-4 and 1 Timothy 6:9-10 oppose and compliment each other?

How does our materialistic culture made it difficult to serve Jesus? If you have kids, how do you handle their craving for material things?

CHALLENGE: Work as a group to plan and organize how you will bless a family through Christmas Blessings. We are focusing on foster families and our Morning Star families. Work together to be the hands and feet of Jesus in our community! We'll match you with a family the week of December 15.
