OPEN: Welcome to a new year and a new decade! As we start this season and learn what it means to be “leading people to pursue a Jesus-first life,” let’s share our thoughts and process through it together.

What stood out from the sermon this week?

READ: Psalm 33:4, Proverbs 2:6, Ephesians 5:18-19, and 2 Timothy 3:16-17.

DIG: According to these passages what would we as a church gain as we place a high priority on God’s word?

According to the above passages, which areas of our lives does God’s word speak to? Why is this important?

How will “anchoring our existence in God’s truth” help us follow Jesus more closely?

What type of word pictures do “radically pursuing” and “anchoring our existence” create? Do they relate/complement each other? Or maybe they contrast each other. Why?
