
COMMUNITY GROUP QUESTIONS

OPEN: Would you rather be able to use only a fork or be able to use only a spoon?

What stood out from the sermon this week?

READ: Psalm 119:9-11, Ephesians 6:5-9, James 1:22-25, and 1 Peter 2:13-16.

DIG: According to the above passages, how do we live out the faith we believe?

According to the above passages, what areas of our life can be seen as a missionary field? Which of these areas do you see fruit when sharing God's love with people around you?

Is it more difficult for you to *show* or *share* the love of Jesus to those around you? Why?

How do we become better and more effective at balancing the choice of acting out the love of Jesus *and* verbally sharing the gospel?

CHALLENGE: Let's participate in our first strategic initiative of the year together: Spend 20 minutes per day with Jesus for 20 weeks, praying for 20 people we could invite to Easter services. Part of that 20 minutes could be following the daily Bible Reading Plan (handed out last Sunday and available on our website at mstar.church). I also challenge you and *your group* to create a list of people to pray for, and invite them to Easter services. Let's listen to God's prompting as we read His word together and pray for those people who need the love of Jesus!
