OPEN: Would you rather be a famous director or actor?

What stood out from the sermon this week?

READ: 1 Corinthians 12:12-27 and Ephesians 4:1-16

DIG: According to these passages, why do we serve?

God has not saved us *because* of our works, but He has saved us to *do* good works. How do you differentiate between those ideas? How does this encourage you to do good works for the Lord?
