

# Community Group Questions

WIND & FIRE: exploring our roots, restoring our passion.

## Open

We are inspired by great achievements (someone breaking a sports record, someone overcoming great adversity). What great human achievement is your favorite? What is one of your greatest personal spiritual victories?

## Dig

Read Acts 2:42-47; 4:32-35; 6:7; 8:1; and 9:31.

In these “progress reports” from Luke on the early church, what values did they hold dear and how did that impact their choices?

Acts 9:31 talks of “walking” in the fear of the Lord. What does it mean to “walk”? (Consider Colossians 1:10, Luke 1:6, 1 Thessalonians 4:1, 1 John 2:6). Practically speaking, how do you walk in the Wind and Fire of God’s Spirit?

Read Acts 9:31 again. What is “building up” all about (some translations say “edify”)? (Consider Romans 14:18 and 15:2, and 1 Corinthians 8:1.)

How can you build up your church family? What change can you make to allow others to better build you up?

## Reflect

Do a “progress report” on yourself. Where are you in your walk with the Lord?

What is one thing the group can do to strengthen and encourage you? Do that “one thing” for one another.
