

COMMUNITY GROUP QUESTIONS

OPEN: Tell us about one of your more “colorful” unbelieving friends.

DIG: Read the story of Zacchaeus in Luke 19:1-10. We heard that Zach was short, rich, and a crook. Which of these characteristics mattered most to Jesus? (This is meant to be a weird question.)

Did Jesus care more about Zach's past or his future? Why? What about you—do you care more about someone's past or future?

Read Luke 19:10. This verse seems to be written in reference to Zach. If Jesus came to seek and save the “lost,” what does this mean for the “found”?

Zach's restitution is a key part of the story. He likely wouldn't have much left after he repaid everyone. What does this say about him?

REFLECT: How does your faith affect your generosity? What are obstacles to generosity for you?
