October 12, 2014 | God In Us [part 1] | Acts 2:1-4

Open

Think of a time when you eagerly anticipated a gift. What was your response when it finally came? What was your response when you first came to faith in Jesus?

Dig

Read Acts 2:1-21. What aspect of the miracle of Pentecost is most interesting or significant for you? Why?

What do the three phrases, “every nation” (verse 5), “on all flesh” (verse 17), and “everyone who calls upon the name” (verse 21) suggest to you?

Of the three symbols of the Holy Spirit we find in Acts 2 (wind, fire, and water), which one helps you better understand how God is at work in your life? Explain your answer.

Consider these verses: John 14:15-17; 1 Corinthians 6:19-20; Ephesians 2:22. According to God’s Word (not your feelings at any given time), if you have come to faith in Jesus, you are the temple of the Holy Spirit! How does it change the way you live and look at life knowing that God is *in* you?

What will you do this week to be better prepared for God’s use?
