

## Community Group Questions

### Open

Share a time when God used someone to reach out to you in a life-changing way OR when He used you to reach out to someone else in a way that blessed their life.

### Dig

Read Acts 3:1-10. How would you have reacted if you were the lame beggar? Why would you react that way?

The crowd was filled with wonder and amazement at what had just happened. How has your response to what Jesus has done in you caused wonder and amazement (or curiosity and questions . . . or anger and rejection) from those who know you?

Peter's sermon is filled with references to Old Testament prophecies. How was the healing of the lame man a fulfillment of prophecy, and to what does it ultimately point? (Hint: check out Isaiah 35:6.) What other prophecies (if any) stand out to you in Peter's sermon?

Which of the following statements do you most identify with, and why?

- A. I believe God does miracles today just like He did in the early church.
- B. I believe God used miracles to initially establish the gospel, but not so much now.
- C. I don't know.

Ponder Acts 3:19-21. How has repentance and turning to God brought times of refreshing to you? How can this be used to encourage others to come to Christ? What refreshing and restoration do you look forward to in the future?
