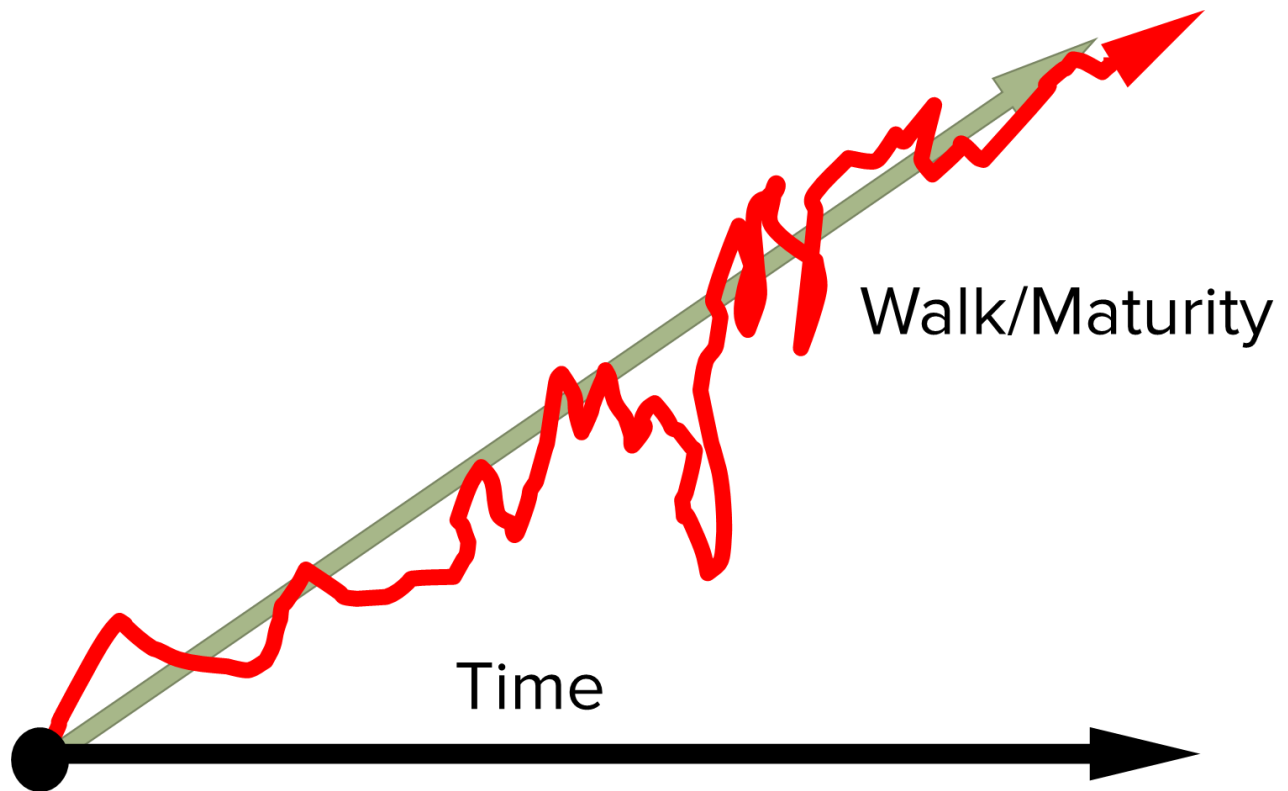
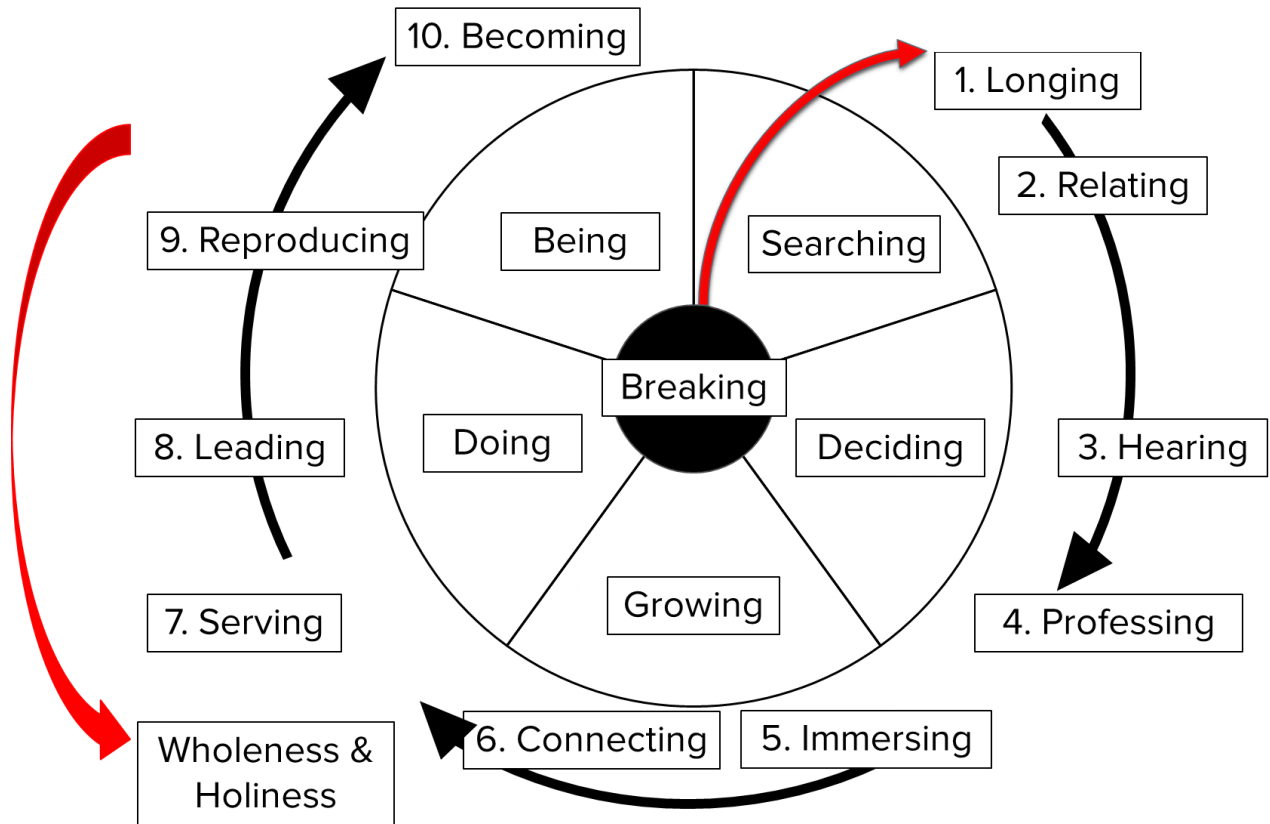

## Relating to God . . . Through His Word

If we belong to God, then God wants us to be in CONSTANT RELATIONSHIP with him. That is why He sent his Son. So how do we grow in RELATIONSHIP with God? What tools do you need?

**1. THE BIBLE:** 66 books. Written by 40 different men, from all walks of life, over the span of 1500 years.

We believe the Bible, while written by men, was INSPIRED by God. While God used 40 authors—there is one ultimate author, GOD.

2 Tim 3:16—“All Scripture is God BREATHED [or inspired by God] and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness.”

### Is the Bible reliable?

There is no book or writing that has more evidence to support its accuracy through the centuries. We have more than 5000 ancient manuscripts of the entire New Testament—and many thousand more fragments.

DEAD SEA SCROLLS: These were 1,000 years older than any manuscript that had previously been known.

### Which Bible translation is right/best?

There is no “right” translation. Translating from one language to another is as much an art as it is a science. And each translation has certain qualities to it that might benefit you based on what your goals are.

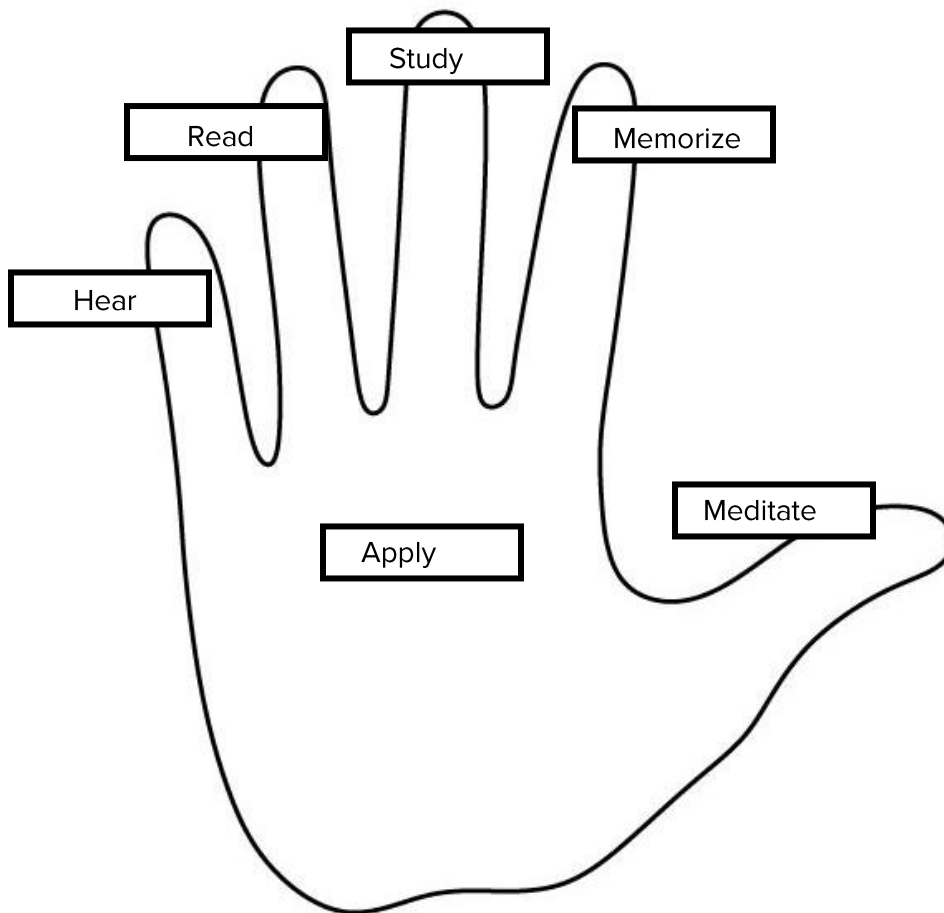
Morning Star generally uses the ESV—English Standard Version. It is a newer, very reliable translation written at a semi-scholarly level.

**Foundational Truth:** These scriptures are the verbally inspired WORD OF GOD, without error in the original writings, the complete revelation of His will for salvation, and the ULTIMATE AUTHORITY over every realm of human knowledge and endeavor. Therefore the Bible is to be BELIEVED in all that it affirms, OBEYED in all that it requires, and TRUSTED in all that it promises.
