Psalm 78:1 (ESV)

1 Give ear, O my people, to my teaching; incline your ears to the words of my mouth!

God wants us to listen carefully to His Word.

Psalm 78:2–3 (ESV)

2 I will open my mouth in a parable; I will utter dark sayings from of old, 3 things that we have heard and known, that our fathers have told us.

*Father Abraham had many sons,
Many sons had Father Abraham,
I am one of them, and so are you,
So let's just praise the Lord!*

Psalm 78:4 (ESV)

4 We will not hide them from their children, but tell to the coming generation the glorious deeds of the Lord, and his might, and the wonders that he has done.

Psalm 78:5–6 (ESV)

5 He established a testimony in Jacob and appointed a law in Israel, which he commanded our fathers to teach to their children, 6 that the next generation might know them, the children yet unborn, and arise and tell them to their children

Deuteronomy 4:7–9 (ESV)

7 For what great nation is there that has a god so near to it as the Lord our God is to us, whenever we call upon him? 8 And what great nation is there, that has statutes and rules so righteous as all this law that I set before you today? 9 “Only take care, and keep your soul diligently, lest you forget the things that your eyes have seen, and lest they depart from your heart all the days of your life. Make them known to your children and your children’s children

Deuteronomy 6:7 (ESV)

7 You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.
